


# 2025 Legislative Session | KPERS Bill Recap

## HB 2130: Allowing KPERS Benefits to be Paid Biweekly or Monthly

### **Quick Look**

HB 2130 would allow retirees and disability benefit recipients under the KPERS, KP&F or Judges plans to choose whether they receive their benefits biweekly or monthly.

### **Hearings**

#### **The Fine Print**

Currently, retirement and disability payments are paid on a monthly basis on the last working day of the month.

Starting July 1, 2026, anyone already receiving benefits or any member who retires after that date can elect biweekly payments instead of the current monthly option. If no choice is made, payments will continue on a monthly basis.

The first benefit payment will always be made on a monthly basis. After receiving their first month's payment, retirees and disability benefit recipients will have the option to elect biweekly payments if they prefer.
