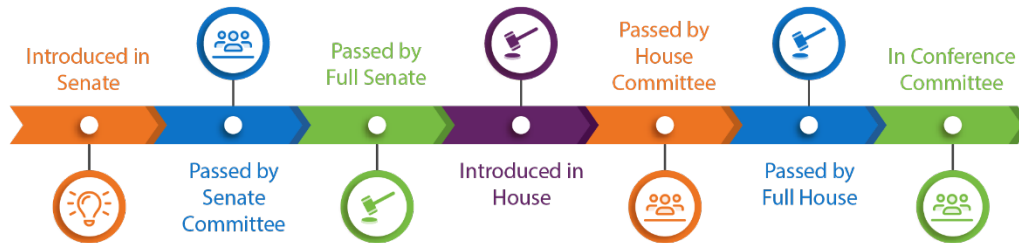


## 2025 Legislative Session | KPERS Bill Recap

### Senate Bill 237: Using Retirement Accounts for Child Support

#### Quick Look

SB 237, as amended by Senate Committee, allows courts to consider KPERS accounts for the payment of child support arrearages.

#### Hearings

February 14 – Senate Judiciary Committee  
 February 17 – Passed Senate Committee as amended  
 March 6 – Passed Senate 40-0  
 March 17 – House Judiciary Committee  
 March 18 – Passed House Judiciary Committee  
 March 20 – Passed House 118-0  
 March 24 – Contents Amended into HB 2062

#### The Fine Print

If a KPERS member becomes delinquent in their child support payments, a court can order the use of the person's KPERS account to make a one-time payment toward the child support arrearage.

The payment is subject to a distributable event (retirement, withdrawal or death) allowed by the plan. This payment would result in an actuarial reduction to the member's lifetime benefit.
